Information Summary

- Race Venue:** Grand Canal Dock, Ringsend, Dublin 4. The Crew Manager's Meeting & Crew Briefings will be held at Waterways Ireland Visitors Centre off Grand Canal Quay.
- Directions:** See attached map - Grand Canal Dock – How to Get Here.
- Parking:** Please make use of public transport where possible, but if you are driving parking is available at Dublin Q-Park Grand Canal Square at a charge of €20 for 24 hours. There is also some free parking in some side roads around the area.
- Course:** The racing course is set within an enclosed dock area over a distance of 200m with a water depth of 4 – 5.5m. The water is non-tidal & does not have a flow. The start & finish will be marked on & off the water. All starts will be free standing starts.

- ALL CREWS ARE TO BE ON SITE AT LEAST 1 HOUR BEFORE THEIR FIRST RACE START TIME TO ALLOW FOR THE SAFETY BRIEFING.**
- Rules of Racing:** The races will be conducted under the IDBF Racing Rules & Regulations, extracts from which are contained in this programme & other conditions as published in this programme. A minimum of 12 paddlers & a maximum of 16 paddlers per boat, plus drummer are permitted for the novice and BCS crews. For the international crews a minimum of 16 paddlers & a maximum of 20 paddlers plus drummer are permitted.
- Prizes Awarded:** Prizes will be awarded for:
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place Overall in the International Challenge
 - 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place Overall in the Novice Challenge
 - 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place Overall in the Breast Cancer Survivor's Challenge
 - Best Fancy Dressed Team (nominations from official's team)
 - Team Raised Most Money For Charity
- Facilities:** Waterways Ireland Visitor's Centre will be available for changing & to act as shelter if the weather is bad. Crews will be able to leave their belongings in a more secure environment whilst racing. Please note space is fairly limited.
- What to Wear:** T-shirt/thermal, shorts/tracksuit, soft soled shoes, waterproof (only if really cold). It is recommended to bring a spare set of clothes as the novice paddler has a tendency to splash more. Denim jeans are NOT allowed to be worn whilst racing in the boat. Buoyancy aids will be provided & are to be worn by all participants.
- Catering:** Grand Canal Quay/Square has a selection of cafes, restaurants & supermarkets.
- Safety:** No ALCOHOL or DRUGS are to be consumed until racing has finished. Medical conditions which may be brought on through exercise should be advised to the boat helm each time you race.
- Security:** As with any large city there may be thieves about, so only bring what you need to the race site & do not leave bags unattended around the dock area.
